Spring 2 (6 weeks)	<p>We Are Scientists!</p> <p>Linking in with <i>Science and Engineering Week</i> (10th – 19th March 2018) a STEM focused half term with links to all areas of the Science curriculum for each cohort.</p> <p>END PRODUCT: STEM Week activities.</p>
Summer 1 (6 weeks)	<p>Northern Pride!</p> <p>The '<i>Great Exhibition of the North</i>', a huge international event takes place in Newcastle starting on 22nd June 2018.
